

Bubbles and Brews 5K F.A.Q.

Bubbles and Brews 5K participants (21 years and older only) will actually have 2 events to choose from – the 5K run with celebratory wine and beer at the finish or the 1K Tasting Walk with 4 wine and beer stops along the route, or BOTH! Each participant will get a t-shirt, a unique finisher medal and a free beverage. The post-race party will feature wine, beer, food, music and awards!

What do I need at the race?

- Photo I.D.
- Appropriate footwear is highly recommended
- Spending money for parking, drinks and food.

When does the event start?

The first wave will begin at 1:00pm. Gates will open at 11:30am. Please arrive by 12:30pm in order to get checked in and ready to run!

How much does it cost?

- February 1 – June 4: \$35 per runner
- June 5 – June 12: \$45 per runner

What to leave at home?

- Outside food and beverage
- Glass containers
- Weapons and/or firearms
- Pets

When and where is Packet Pickup?

Beat the Race Day crowds and come by Sozo Friday, June 11 between 5pm and 7pm to pick up your race packet! Race Day packet pickup will also be available starting at 11:30am. Don't forget your photo I.D. to get your packet!

Can I pick up my friends' packet?

Yes, but you will need the following items:

- Copy of your friend's photo I.D.
- Signed letter from the friend stating you are allowed to pick up their packet

What do I get as a race participant?

- Bubbles and Brews 5K Race T-shirt
- Custom Bubbles and Brews 5K Medal
- Bubbles and Brews 5K Race Bib with free beverage ticket

Where can I leave my gear?

There will be a free gear check area for all of your gear. Your gear check claim ticket is attached to your race bib.

What if there is inclement weather?

Rain or shine, we will race! Bubbles and Brews 5K reserves the right to cancel or delay the event if runner, spectator or staff safety is compromised. There will be no refunds.

How do I volunteer?
